CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN TO ACCEPT A BID FROM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LANDMARK STRUCTURES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A 500,000 GALLON ELEVATED PEDASTAL TYPE STEEL WATER TANK FOR THE TONTITOWN WATER TOWER PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tontitown has determined that betterments and improvements to the water facilities should be made in order that the City and its inhabitants may have adequate and proper water facilities;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the desire for betterments and improvements to the city's water facilities, the City Council has approved the undertaking of a project to consist of the installation of a new 500,000 gallon elevated pedestal type steel water tank;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Tontitown, in accordance with state law, advertised for bids from contractors interested in performing the work to construct and install said 500,000 gallon elevated pedestal type steel water tank and received many qualified candidates; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid was submitted by Landmark Structures for \$1,579,000.00, and following the receipt of the recommendations to accept this bid from the city's engineer and the City Council for the City of Tontitown desires that the Mayor accept this bid and proceed with an agreement with Landmark Structures as they are the best qualified to provide engineering services for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in connection with the selection of Landmark Structures as the lowest bid and best qualified to provide the services for the project, the Mayor of Tontitown, Arkansas, on behalf of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is authorized to enter into a Contract for Engineering Services (the "Contract") with Landmark Structures for the water tower project.
