A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE POLICE CHIEF AUTHORITY TO CONTINUE WITH THE ARKANSAS HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROJECT MINI GRANT

WHEREAS, the Tontitown City Council has determined that the Tontitown Community meets eligibility requirements to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Highway Office Selective Traffic Enforcement Project Mini Grant for the continuation of 2018 and apply for said grant in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, and the Tontitown Police Department has shown the need for assistance from the Arkansas Highway Safety Office in the form of additional funds for all Tontitown Police Department Officers to work additional hours in order to make the roadways inside the City of Tontitown safer for all of the citizens and motorists.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the Mayor of Tontitown be hereby authorized to continue administer grant funds from the grant already awarded for the calendar years of 2017/2018 as well as submit an application for the purpose of securing grant funds in the upcoming and further years in which the grant may be available to aid and assist with payment of extra officers to help provide safer streets in the community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Tontitown City Council, recognizes the need for the project, concurs its importance, and supports the Tontitown Community in its efforts to proceed with the same. Further, the Mayor of Tontitown is hereby authorized to continue with the current grant as well as submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Highway Office Selective Traffic Enforcement Project Mini Grant for the purpose of securing the state grant funds to aid and assist the Tontitown Community in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor or Recorder/Treasurer of Tontitown is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project as well as matching funds for completion of said project.
