**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN TO APPLY FOR THE STAFFING OF ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (“SAFER”) GRANT FROM FEMA ON BEHALF OF THE TONTITOWN FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

The Mayor of the City of Tontitown is hereby authorized to submit an application to FEMA to request funding to help increase or maintain the number of trained, front line firefighters for the City of Tontitown.
