

**Tontitown Historical Museum (THM) Report
for the COW Meeting November 19, 2019**

THM Board of Directors met on Monday, November 4, 2019.

1. **HVAC** - Besides concern over the air conditioning last summer, the furnace pilot light went out twice in one week with the cold snap earlier this month. Many thanks to James Clark and Scott Ardemagni for their quick intervention to relight the pilot and keep the building warm. Brinker did a service call and the furnace has continued to run for now. We requested written proposals from Brinker and Paschal for an HVAC replacement unit, including the addition of ductwork to improve air circulation in the front rooms. Both of these companies have serviced THM's units in the past.
2. **Windows 10** -- The museum laptop is running Windows 7, which Microsoft will not support after January 4. Our laptop will need to be upgraded along with other city computers.
3. **Board Resignation** -- Roger Pianalto resigned from the Board this month due to family issues. Roger has been an exceptional asset to the Board, serving diligently since 2006. He will be greatly missed. Roger assures us that he will still volunteer to help with events or special projects. We are deeply grateful for Roger's continued service and support.
