



The City of Tontitown's Farmers Market will be at the Harry Sbanotto Park in Tontitown again this year! Beginning May 1st, vendors can come and sell their locally grown produce/products every **Saturday from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm**. The city will charge **NO FEES** again this year! All produce grown or products manufactured must be sourced from Washington, Benton, or Madison counties to keep it "local". Set up will be on the East side of the park between the fire station and the museum. You can sell out of your truck or set up a small, covered awning in the grass, along the parking lot. All spaces are on a first come, first serve basis. Please do not park in the grassy areas, you may unload near the museum but **MUST** park in the park parking lot. Your prices must be posted and we ask that all items be sold by measure (item, bunch, pint, quart, bushel, etc.) No scales allowed. Baked goods or processed foods must be in compliance with **AR Cottage Food Law and AR Health Dept. policies**. All vendors are responsible for clean-up of their space.
