Grants

The department applied for a Firehouse Subs grant for the purchase of battery powered extrication equipment. The amount of the grant was \$23,937.85 and does not require matching funds by the city. The grants will be awarded in the second quarter of this year.

The department also received a \$1,000 donation from Nino's Trading Company. Part of the money was used to purchase a Smart TV that will be used by our training division. Several in-house classes for our volunteers have already been scheduled and this TV will be used for many of the classes. The balance of the money will be used to purchase personal protective equipment.

Training

The fire marshal received 7.0 hours of continuing education hours that focused on Fire Alarm Inspection and Testing per NFPA 72. This class was put on by the Automatic Fire Alarm Association. This class is also an approved International Code Council (ICC) course.

The fire marshal is also our Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR instructor. He completed his renewal for this certification. He also taught a CPR renewal class for nine individuals.
