

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-10-966B

CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2021 BUDGET TO ACCOUNT FOR RELIEF FUNDS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT AND OTHER REVENUE.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the federal government enacted Public Law 117-2 (the "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021" or "ARPA") to provide additional relief to address the continued impact of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") pandemic on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown has been directly awarded ARPA funds in the amount of \$450,268.85; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown has also received grant funding through an award of a SAFER grant for the Tontitown Fire Department and a Hazardous Mitigation Grant for the clean-up of drainage and creek restoration which should be reflected as new revenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tontitown believes it to be necessary to amend the 2021 budget to account for the new revenue from ARPA and other funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tontitown as follows:

The 2021 Budget shall hereby be amended and the sum of \$450,268.85 shall be reflected as received to the General Fund to be held in an account established to hold ARPA funds until appropriated by further action of the City Council.


