Kenneth Lovett received an email from Stephen Foster with A.D.E.Q. regarding the emissions from the waste energy plant. The regulated emissions from the source of the engines and flares are as follows- particulate matter pm 10, SO2, VOC, CO, NOX and these emissions are permitted by the State of Arkansas. Heinz Braun with A.D.E.Q. said the state does not have specific equipment available to test, so they recommend that if you so wish to test that you may hire a firm and work out a sampling plan with that company. Mr. Lovett said there has been several complaints that has been sent to A.D.E.Q and feel that they are being brushed off and ignored. Mr. Lovett has requested that the council discuss purchasing equipment, training and do the testing ourselves or hire somebody.

Dennis Boyer said that A.D.E.Q. has not yet acted on approving the Waste Management Expansion Project for Tontitown therefore there is still time to stop it, if each one of the council feels inclined to act now. A.D.E.Q. has stated that it welcomes more information from the residents of Tontitown before making a final decision. Mr. Boyer has the A.D.E.Q. contact information for the written concerns. With the councils help we could possibly stop the expansion from being approved or stop it dead in its tracks.

Rocky Clinton with the Tontitown Planning Commission said it was his opinion that Mr. Lovett is very well qualified in what he's speaking about because of his background.
