



The Tontitown Market (formerly Tontitown Farmers' Market) will be at the Harry Sbanotto Park in Tontitown again this year! Beginning April 2nd, vendors can come & sell their locally grown produce/products every Saturday from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm. There will be a \$5 application fee. If your application is approved, there will be a one-time \$20 vendor fee due opening day. All produce grown or products manufactured must be

sourced from Washington, Benton, or Madison counties to keep it "local". Booths will be assigned a designated area in the park to set up weekly. If you need special accommodations such as electricity, close to a particular area/building, etc., please indicate this on your application. Booth spaces will be set up along the walking path in the park as well as, along Henri De Tonti Blvd. Please do not park in the grassy areas, you may unload near the museum but MUST park in the park parking lot. Your prices must be posted, and we ask that all items be sold by measure (item, bunch, pint, quart, bushel, etc.) No scales allowed. Baked goods or processed foods must comply with AR Cottage Food Law and AR Health Dept. policies. All vendors are responsible for the clean-up of their space.
