CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TONTITOWN MASTER TRANSPORTATION PLAN IN ORDER TO RECLASSIFY BANDINI AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Tontitown Master Transportation Plan was adopted by the Tontitown City Council in 2018 in order to provide for orderly growth and development within in the City of Tontitown; and

WHEREAS, in the course of the design of the Tontitown Fire Department, it has come to the attention of the City Council that it is necessary to amend the Master Transportation Plan to reclassify Bandini Avenue as a two (2) lane local roadway in order to allow for appropriate ingress and egress for emergency vehicles and to provide for appropriate vehicle accessibility to the city park as well as other local traffic; and

WHEREAS, after thorough review, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest and benefit to the citizens of Tontitown to approve of the proposed amendment to the Tontitown Master Transportation Plan, as reflected herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

Section 1. The Mayor and her designees are hereby authorized to amend the Tontitown Master Transportation Plan in order to reclassify Bandini Avenue as a two (2) lane local roadway.

Section 2. That it is the desire of the Tontitown City Council that in conjunction with the Fire Department project, Bandini Avenue shall be designed as a two (2) lane local roadway with appropriate ingress and egress for emergency vehicles and to provide for appropriate vehicle accessibility to the city park as well as other local traffic.

Section 2. The remainder of the Master Transportation Plan not specifically revised herein shall hereby remain in full force and effect.
