Comments from Planning Commission

James Dean

1. As a commission, we really need to think about giving final plat approval, before everything is done, due to what happened with the Veneto Project as far as widening of the street not being completed by the

developer and now this is going to cost the citizens a couple of hundred thousand to finish the project.

Approximately four months ago, James told the mayor, engineer, and street department that the issues were going to be a possibility and he was assured that there were mechanisms in place to prevent this from happening. We need to look hard at the plat approvals without all conditions being met.

2. Kevin Boortz added that there are conditions that absolutely need to be completed and there are conditions that are conditional, so if codes need to be changed and addressed that's what we need to do.
