I can't remember, but I did this quote as if we would invoice Tontitown. This is for one sample. If we are going to do 5 manholes, 3 times per day, for 7 days, then you would multiply this by 105 for a grand total of \$6825. We can always change this and just do ammonia or not do as many sulfates or pH's. I'm going to be out of town next week. We could kick off the project June 30th. I can drive around and locate the manholes based on the map that we received. I will try to get that done this week so we will be ready for whenever you decide to have us start.

I have not made any headway in locating equipment to test for hydrogen sulfide, but I will continue working on that project. I will send a quote for that as soon as I know how much it is going to cost to rent equipment.
