A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION’S REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE) GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown, Arkansas, is a municipal corporation located in Washington County, Arkansas, being duly created, organized, and existing under the laws of the State of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown has identified a significant need to improve its infrastructure, including improvements to South Barrington Road, including but not limited to, repaving, road-widening, sidewalk installation, and other infrastructure improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that applying for and receiving grant monies, and specifically applying for and receiving the RAISE grant, will result in substantial financial savings to the City and will further increase safety and security for citizens and visitors of Tontitown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tontitown as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Tontitown hereby declares support for and hereby approves the City of Tontitown to apply for the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (“RAISE”) Grant with the U.S. Department of Transportation and declares its support to use awarded grant funding for the South Barrington Road Infrastructure Project.
