CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A USED ¾ TON OR 1 TON PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown requires a reliable pickup truck to support municipal operations and departmental field work; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase one (1) used ¾ ton or 1 ton pickup truck meeting the following minimum specifications: four (4) door crew cab configuration, four-wheel drive (4WD), automatic transmission, diesel engine; and

WHEREAS, the availability of used vehicles meeting the City’s required specifications is limited and often time-sensitive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to waive competitive bidding in order to allow the City to promptly select and purchase a vehicle that meets its operational needs; and

WHEREAS, the total purchase price shall not exceed Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), and funds for this purchase have been budgeted under fixed assets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas as follows:

Section 1. Competitive bidding is hereby waived, and the City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) used ¾ ton or 1 ton pickup truck.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) used ¾ ton or 1 ton pickup truck meeting the minimum specifications set forth herein, in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the purchase consistent with this Resolution.
