**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF TUITION FOR FIVE (5)
INDIVIDUALS TO ATTEND PARAMEDIC SCHOOL FOR THE TONTITOWN FIRE
DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown Fire Department provides emergency medical and fire protection services to the residents of the City and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, advanced medical training for fire department personnel improves the quality of emergency medical services and enhances the department's ability to respond to critical incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has identified five (5) individuals to attend paramedic school in order to increase the number of certified paramedics serving the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that investing in advanced medical training for fire department personnel is beneficial to the safety, health, and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the payment of tuition for five (5) individuals to attend paramedic school on behalf of the Tontitown Fire Department.

Section 2. Payment of tuition and associated training expenses shall be made in accordance with available budgeted funds and applicable City policies.
