CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF WATER DEPARTMENT RESERVE FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE ONE MILLION (1,000,000) GALLON WATER STORAGE TANK PROJECT IN THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tontitown is undertaking the construction of a one million (1,000,000) gallon water storage tank to improve system capacity, water pressure stability, and long-term infrastructure reliability; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is primarily funded through the City's 2025 Sales Tax Bond proceeds; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funds are necessary to complete the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Water Department maintains reserve funds designated for capital improvements and infrastructure needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the use of Water Department reserve funds to supplement the 2025 Sales Tax Bond proceeds is necessary and in the best interest of the City to ensure completion of the project.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas as follows:

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby authorizes the use of Water Department reserve funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) to complete the one million (1,000,000) gallon water storage tank project, supplementing the 2025 Sales Tax Bond funding.

**Section 2.** The Mayor and Water Department officials are authorized to take all necessary actions consistent with this Resolution to ensure completion of the project.
