CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM – ATTRIBUTABLE FUNDS ADMINSTRATED BY THE NORTHWEST ARKANSAS REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR A PROJECT TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO EXTEND DON TYSON PARKWAY FROM HWY 112 TO KELLY ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to begin a feasibility study which includes 30% conceptual design and environmental clearance for approximately 2.26 miles; and

WHEREAS, the current application request is \$850,000 to be put toward the feasible study; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands the federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands that there will be no reimbursement for any work accomplished prior to issuance by the Arkansas Department of transportation of an official notice to Proceed; and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

Section 1. The city of Tontitown will participate in accordance with its designated responsibilities.
