CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM OR RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands that Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) or Recreational Trails Program (RTP) funds are available at eighty percent (80%) federal participation and twenty percent (20%) local match to develop or improve the Community Center Trail Access Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands that such federal funds are available on a reimbursable basis, requiring project costs to be incurred and paid prior to reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown acknowledges that any project utilizing federal funding must be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the City for the life of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that participation in these programs is in the best interest of the City and will enhance recreational opportunities and connectivity within the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas as follows:

Section 1. The City of Tontitown hereby agrees to participate in the Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program or Recreational Trails Program in accordance with its designated responsibilities, including long-term maintenance of the project.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the development and construction of the Community Center Trail Access project.


Section 3. The City of Tontitown hereby pledges its full support for this project and authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action necessary to implement the project.
