**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN SUPPORTING THE
HIGHWAY 412/BARRINGTON PROJECT AS CURRENTLY PLANNED**

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown recognizes the importance of transportation infrastructure to the continued economic development, public safety, and quality of life of residents and businesses within the region; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Highway 412/Barrington project has been planned, financed by way of grant funding and developed to improve traffic flow, roadway safety, accessibility for pedestrian, freight mobility, and long-term transportation efficiency within the affected corridor; and

WHEREAS, the project has undergone planning, engineering, public coordination, and evaluation processes intended to identify the most effective and practical design for meeting present and future transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds that proceeding with the Highway 412/Barrington project as currently planned is in the best interest of the community and surrounding region; and

WHEREAS, delays, redesigns, or substantial deviations from the current plan may negatively impact project delivery timelines, increase project costs, delay economic development opportunities, and postpone anticipated safety and mobility improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to formally express its support for the continued advancement and completion of the Highway 412/Barrington project as presently designed and scheduled.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TONTITOWN:**

Section 1. That the City Council hereby expresses its full support for the Highway 412/Barrington project as currently planned.

Section 2. That the City of Tontitown encourages all relevant local, regional, state, and federal agencies to continue advancing the project without unnecessary delay or material alteration.

Section 3. That the City of Tontitown recognizes the anticipated public benefits associated with the project, including improved transportation efficiency, enhanced roadway safety, economic growth opportunities, and increased regional connectivity.

Section 4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to provide copies of this Resolution to all appropriate agencies, elected officials, and project stakeholders.
