**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN SUPPORTING THE  
HIGHWAY 412/BARRINGTON PROJECT AS CURRENTLY PLANNED**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tontitown recognizes the importance of transportation infrastructure to the continued economic development, public safety, and quality of life of residents and businesses within the region; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Highway 412/Barrington project has been planned, financed by way of grant funding and developed to improve traffic flow, roadway safety, accessibility for pedestrian, freight mobility, and long-term transportation efficiency within the affected corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the project has undergone planning, engineering, public coordination, and evaluation processes intended to identify the most effective and practical design for meeting present and future transportation needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body finds that proceeding with the Highway 412/Barrington project as currently planned is in the best interest of the community and surrounding region; and

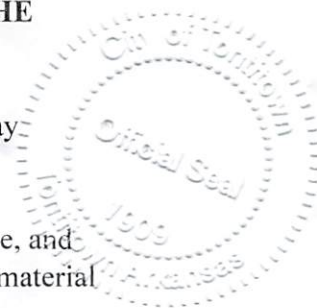

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF TONTITOWN:**

**Section 2.** That the City of Tontitown encourages all relevant local, regional, state, and federal agencies to continue advancing the project without unnecessary delay or material alteration.
