**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF A 2024 NISSAN ROGUE

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown maintains a fixed asset inventory for equipment and vehicles owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Tontitown Police Department previously added a 2024 Nissan Rogue, VIN #5N1BT3BB7RC709578, to the City's fixed asset inventory; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to remove said vehicle from the Police Department fixed asset list; and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds that authorizing the removal of this vehicle from the fixed asset inventory is in the best interest of the City and necessary for accurate recordkeeping.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the removal of one (1) 2024 Nissan Rogue, VIN #5N1BT3BB7RC709578, from the Tontitown Police Department fixed asset inventory.

Section 2. The Mayor, City Clerk-Treasurer, and appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute any documents and make any accounting or inventory adjustments necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
