

July Report:

- **Street and Stormwater**

412/Barrington – A letter was sent to David Siskowski, Local Program Director for ARDOT outlying the changes to the project which include the removal of tunnel and reduction of shared-use path on the northside of Washington to a 6-foot-wide sidewalk to stay within the existing ROW as requested by PAM.

1st Phase of Fletcher is scheduled for final next week.

2nd Phase of Fletcher is waiting for directions from an Attorney to address eminent domain on the needed property.

Scott and I met with Crafton-Tull engineers last week to discuss the progress on the 20-year pavement study.

Stormwater work on South Barrington is scheduled to start on Monday, August 24.

- **Grants**

Corridor Study will be funded for 2027.

We are still waiting for the results of the submittal of the Hazardous Mitigation Grant for Sbanotto.

We are still waiting for the results of the TAP grant which addresses parking and drainage along Zulpo Street.

Submittal for a Park Placement grant was completed on July 29.

I have a meeting with a representative from the Walton Family Foundation this week to discuss the Community Building project.
